Market Update

The economic situation of the last 2 and a half years has proven to be a challenging financial time in the United States. The nation's top economists and the politicians cannot agree on a resolution for the current situation. The U S has suffered many economic downturns since the market crash of 1929. However, small businesses helped bring the country out of the Great Depression and history tells us that it will bounce back, but to what degree and what the new paradigm will be is yet to be determined.

What the markets will do and how businesses react is the big question. Competition and adversity have always forced small businesses to become better merchants. The staff at Pawnee Buttes Seed is dedicated to providing the product, service and technical knowledge to be the best merchants in the seed industry. We genuinely appreciate our customers, our staff and the opportunity to face the challenges of the future.

Government Purchasing

Historically, the federal government and the Bureau of Land Management in particular, has been the largest consumer of native seed in the U.S. Government purchases of seed have dramatically decreased with federal government agencies. State, county and city governments are facing cutbacks due to falling tax revenues and priorities. This has left a lot of seed inventory in the industry and, coupled with falling demand from consumers across the board; it did not take long for prices to start falling.

Low demand and higher commodity prices for corn, wheat and soybeans forced many seed growers to plow out production acres of native and reclamation seed crops. Many native species are trading at a 25 year low.

However, the market is showing signs that it has hit bottom and has started to stabilize. Current reports show that consumer spending has started to creep up and wise decisions on investments are starting to show positive returns.

The latest Conservation Reserve Program program has created a new demand and has strengthened the prices on some cool season and warm season grasses and also on many of the forb "pollinator" species.

Turf Report

Sinking prices have forced many growers to plow out production acres and replant with annual cash crops. It is estimated that nearly 400,000 acres in Oregon's Willamette Valley have been taken out of production. Decreasing demand has left many growers with a large inventory.

Turf type tall fescues have been hit hard and are still trading at low prices.

Perennial ryegrasses have been holding and seem to be stronger.

Forage Type Tall Fescue has also been holding and seems to be stronger.

Fine fescues and common Kentucky Bluegrasses are about the same as last year.

Public varieties of Kentucky Bluegrass are holding. **Bentgrass** prices are steady.

Pasture and Forage Report

Prices on items such as orchardgrass, bromegrass, forage fescues, and perennial ryegrasses are close to last year. The supplies will eventually fall in line with demand as more production acres are plowed out and replanted with other crops.

Reclamation and Conservation Report

The reclamation and conservation arm of the industry is getting stronger. The 2011 CRP sign-up has increased prices on some grasses and "pollinator" forb species.

Cool season grass prices are getting stronger across the board compared to last year.

Native warm season grass prices are steady and inventories are not extremely large. Prices should stabilize soon.

Forbs and shrubs are in short supply and have been getting stronger. Significant price increases with most species showing fair to moderate gains. Fair availability.

Alfalfas/Small Grains

Proprietary alfalfas are stable, as is the supply. However supply for public varieties is not excessive and could tighten throughout the year with some price increases to be seen.

Clover pricing is stable with fair to moderate supply. The one exception may be Yellow Blossom Sweet Clover – showing poor supply and the one item that will be higher priced in comparison to last year.

Small grains such as rye, oats, barley, wheat, and triticale are all in good supply, and prices should be comparable to 2010.

The nature of Nature

Nature," Mother Nature", generally refers to the various types of living plants and animals, and to the processes associated with the way that things exist and change our landscape. There is no doubt that plants are one of the world's most successful life forms. However, Nature can give us some good years and also some bad years. Not always the best years for plants to establish.

Often it is desirable to plant native seeds to improve and conserve our lands. Usually we can expect to establish good stands knowing we must apply all the best technologies and techniques. We must consider weed competition, seedbed preparation, seeding methods, timing, soils, using adapted species and assure seed quality.

However, not all species respond the same. Some grasses and "pollinator" forbs species have learned to wait for the periodic "good year" to establish stands. Some seeds stay dominant for several years waiting for the right season and weather conditions to germinate.

Mother Nature has a way of disappointing us from time to time, by either not bringing one of the essential ingredients, or bringing too much all at once. Therefore, our expectations of a fully established stands every year may not always happen. It may just be, "The nature of Nature".

The Conservation Reserve Program

The Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) is a voluntary program for agricultural landowners administered by the USDA Farm Service Agency. Through CRP, you receive annual rental payments and cost-share assistance to establish approved grasses. This has the potential to impact soil erosion, wildlife habitat, water quality, farm incomes and rural economies.

March 14th, 2011 marked the 41st sign-up period. In Colorado, thousands of acres of CRP will be expiring in the next two years. Acreages enrolled, or re-enrolled, in CRP will be seeded to resource-conserving vegetative covers including pollinator species of forbs. The pollinator mixes were introduced with the 39th signup in August, 2010.

CRP provides environmental benefits to wildlife, water quality and air quality. Wildlife benefits from the increase in cover and habitat while strong vegetative cover reduces runoff and leaching, improving water quality. Reducing wind erosion on the farm improves air quality and the pollinator species increase plant and wildlife diversity.

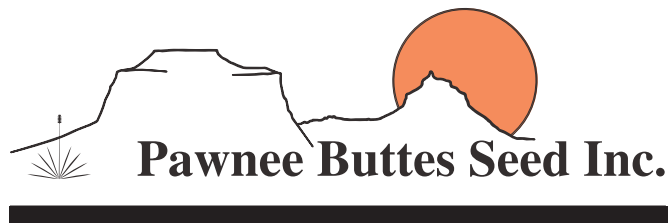
